

SNOW & ICE REMOVAL:

Please help keep our streets and Sidewalks clear of snow and Ice. By ordinance Front, Corner and Side yard sidewalks must be cleared by the owner, Agent, or occupant. Vehicles should not be parked on the road during a snow and until snow removal is completed. If parked on the roadway, remember to observe the ODD & EVEN Parking Rule according to house numbers. For downtown sidewalks, it is the property owner/occupant's responsibility to make sure the sidewalks are cleared.

Garbage, Recycling and Yard Waste

- 1. Totes need to be curbside by 6AM to guarantee pickup.
- 2. All household trash outside of carts <u>must be bagged</u>
- 3. There is a limit of <u>only ONE bulk item per week</u>. (Bulk Items: Household items such as chairs, tables, beds, mattresses, which are too large for tote). If you should have more bulk items, or need an extra tote, please contact Northern Illinois Disposal 1-800-930-7321 to make appropriate arrangements. This would be at your expense.

Please note that YARD WASTE pick up is part of our contract with Northern Illinois Disposal. If you burn yard waste, please be considerate of your neighbors and the amount of smoke going towards them.

YARD WASTE:

- 1. Your yard waste should be put out for NI Disposal on Fridays, from April November.
- 2. If you should have larger tree limbs or brush, you may call the Public Works Department at 815-824-2127 to arrange for the dump truck to be parked at your residence for <u>you to load</u>. Once loaded, call them back and they will pick up the loaded truck.
- 3. You may also take yard waste up to the Public Works building at 206 S. Blackhawk Street and put it into the large dumpster on the south side of the building, <u>marked Yard Waste</u>.

RECYCLING: All recycling is to be loose in the tote. It can not be in any plastic bags inside the tote. This makes it "**contaminated**" and causes the entire truck to be sent to the garbage dump. Also, NO shredded paper in recycling, shredded paper goes into the garbage tote.

<u>LEAF PICKUP</u> by the Village: Beginning in October, leaves are to be piled between the sidewalk and the curb, so that the Village Public Works department can drive down the street and vacuum them up. Please **do not** pile them around the fire hydrants, utility poles or guide wires. Please make sure that you are piling ONLY LEAVES. <u>No sticks or pumpkins</u>. These can cause damage to the equipment.

REMINDERS: Totes must be **Removed** from **Streets** *and* **Sidewalks** by end of pick-up day.

- Upcoming Holiday trash pickup date: Saturday after Thanksgiving. As of now, pick up remains on Friday the week of Christmas and New Years.
- > Yard Waste Pickup ends the last Friday of November 2023 for the season and resumes the first Friday of April 2024
