Building Permits are required for work performed inside and outside your home or business (Ordinance 8-2-1), including for new construction, additions, remodeling, siding, roofs, sheds, fences, decks, swimming pools, electrical updates/changes, plumbing updates/changes, structural changes, and demolition. For questions, please contact B&F Construction Code Services at 847-428-7010. Depending on the scope of work and the completeness of submittal documents for plan review, it can take a up to a week or more before permit will be issued. Please plan projects accordingly. It is the responsibility of the property owner or their contractor to apply for permits and request inspections. The property owner is responsible for ensuring that appropriate building permits are obtained.
